Proposed Council Resolution 16-43 (Amending the FY 2016-2017 UPWP to reflect

the contribution of actual FY 2015-2016 rollover amounts)

The adopted *FY 2016-2017 Unified Planning Work Program* (UPWP) includes estimated rollover amounts for several projects that were not expected to be completed by March 31, 2016 (i.e., the end of FY 2015-2016). These estimated rollover amounts were based on actual expenses through the third quarter of FY 2015-2016 (i.e., December 31, 2015). Now that the accounting for FY 2015-2016 has been closed out, the budgets for these projects for FY 2016-2017 can be adjusted to reflect actual rollover amounts.

Individual projects for which adjustments between estimated versus actual rollover amounts are required are presented in Exhibit 1 of the attached Proposed Council Resolution.
